Discussion questions (part 1) for the online reading logs

Your first writing task, if you choose to accept it

(JK. Of course you have to accept it.)

- 1. Introduce us to your main character. I am looking for a paragraph that answers all of these questions.
 - a. What is your main character's name? (Start paragraph with this sentence "[Character's name] is the main character in [Book's title].
 - b. What does he/she look like?
 - c. What is something you like/admire about him/her? Why?
 - d. What is something you would change about him/her? Why?
 - e. What is his/her home life like (i.e. parents, siblings, conflicts)?*Please remember that a paragraph uses complete sentences.
- Respond to two other people. Tell them why your character would be a friend or "frenemy" of their characters, based on the description posted here. Look for commonalities, such as if their character is a bookworm or into football, or has a lovely chin, or alternately some characteristic that would make him/her someone your character would avoid.
- 3. Tell me what page you have read up to. (Please be accurate! <u>I reserve</u> <u>the right to ask you questions at any time from your book up to the</u> <u>page you have read to.</u> *Remember, your book should be in class with you at all times so if you finish early, you can work on your reading goal. Being unprepared with your novel will cost you your classwork points.)
